

Recall On Propane Adapter Hoses

Recall Notice

The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) issued a recall notice for about 19,500 Gas One propane adapter hoses, which are designed to be used with propane tanks. The hose can swell during use, causing gas to leak and posing a fire hazard.

The recalled propane adapter hoses are part of manufacturer batch numbers Pearl River 3Q20 and Pearl River 4Q20, which is stamped on the hose. It involves model numbers: 50140-08, 50140-012, 50140-05GA and 50140.

They were sold online at [amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com), [ebay.com](https://www.ebay.com), [gasone.com](https://www.gasone.com), [homedepot.com](https://www.homedepot.com) and [walmart.com](https://www.walmart.com) from December 2020 through February 2021, for approximately \$9 to \$18.

You should immediately stop using the adapter hose and contact Gas One to obtain a free replacement hose, according to the CPSC.
